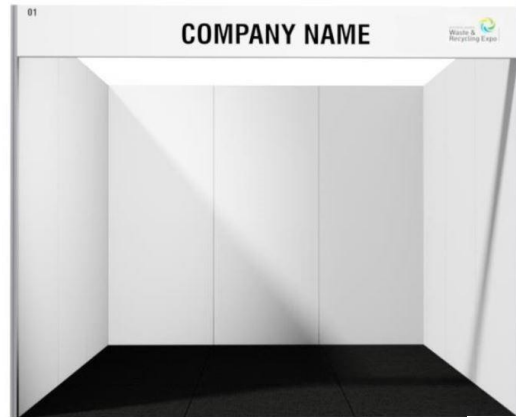

AWRE 2023 WALK ON PACKAGE STAND SPECIFICATION



Please note the above left image is a render only of a 3x3 corner to provide an idea of what the final build will look like. Included furniture package looks like the one on the bottom right.

FURNITURE PACKAGE

1 x Lockable Cupboard (L: 1000mm x W: 500mm x H: 900mm); 1 x Meeting Table and 2 x Chairs

WALLING

Shell Scheme walls are white laminated infills that are slotted into a matte anodized aluminium frame. The overall walling height is 2.4mH.

FLOORING

Charcoal carpet tiles.

FASCIA SIGN

The fascia consists of a customized digital print panel on paper board. A nameboard fascia will be provided for all aisle sides. Each sign will be a maximum of 25 UPPERCASE characters including spaces. Words such as Company, Limited, Brothers etc cannot be used and no punctuation will be used.

LIGHTING

1 x LED arm light per 9sqm.

POWER

1 x 4amp power outlet and test & tag of up to 10 items is included with your stand. Additional power can be ordered through the official electrical supplier ExpoNet, by completing the Lighting/Power Order Form.

SUPPORT PANELS (if required)

Support panels may be necessary to structurally support a stand and to comply with OH&S requirements. These panels will be either 0.5m or 1m wide dependent on the size of the wall being supported and are installed either at right angles to the back wall, or in the middle of a long length of back wall. If you require clarification as to whether your stand will require bracing, please contact ExpoNet.

ADDITIONS

Additional items for your stand may be ordered directly from the official contractor ExpoNet. Please refer to the online exhibitor manual for further details or email esd@exponet.com.au.

Items Allowed on Walls:

When attaching anything to the walls exhibitors are asked to use only Blutac, double sided tape or 3M removable products.

Wall mounted shelving and slat wall is available to hire through ExpoNet.

Digital print wall graphics can be purchased through ExpoNet.

Items Not Allowed:

Do not use pins, staples, screws, nails, bolts, glue or paint as these items cause permanent damage to the walling panels.

Charges will apply to ALL damage caused.

Do not assume anything can be attached to the walls as it may compromise the strength of the wall. ExpoNet can provide advice should you have more detailed mounting or dressing requirements.
